

## Exceptionally spacious village home with an open aspect

If you have been searching for a property with lots of living accommodation and plenty of outdoor space, this CHAIN FREE terraced home is bound to be of interest.

The property, which backs onto a large recreation area, is understood to have been built in 1938 and has been occupied by the same family ever since. Set in very generous sized gardens, the house includes 2 separate reception rooms and 4 good sized bedrooms.

Whilst the house may need a little cosmetic updating, it has been well maintained and benefits from gas fired central heating and uPVC sealed unit glazing.

The property is situated close to the centre of Stanton and backs onto the village recreation ground. Stanton offers an excellent range of amenities including Primary School, Church, Mini Market, Post Office, Hairdressers, Public House, Petrol Station, Community Centre and Doctors Surgery.

The historic market town of Bury St. Edmunds is around 10 miles to the south, where you will find superb educational, recreational and shopping facilities. Diss is around 12 miles to the north and has a mainline rail link to London Liverpool Street.

On the ground floor: The entrance hall, with cloakroom off, gives access to the large dual-aspect sitting room and a separate dining room. The kitchen includes a fitted hob and an integrated double oven. There is a walk-in pantry and a door to the outside.

On the first floor; The landing gives access to all 4 bedrooms and the family shower room. Bedrooms 1,2 and 3 are good sized double bedrooms and bedroom 4 is a very comfortable single room.

## Outside

The gardens to the front of the house are of an open-plan design and are laid mainly to lawn. The large rear gardens are a wonderful feature of the house and are enclosed by fencing. Laid extensively to lawn the gardens include a sheltered patio area, a useful timber shed and 2 brick built storage sheds. There is also the benefit of a side pedestrian access.

AGENTS NOTE: There is no allocated parking but residents tend to park either in the road or on the grassed area by the bus stop.

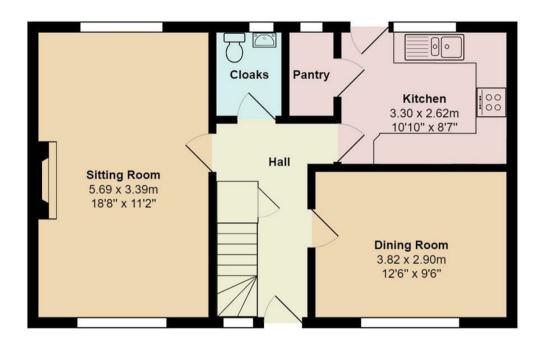
## Directions

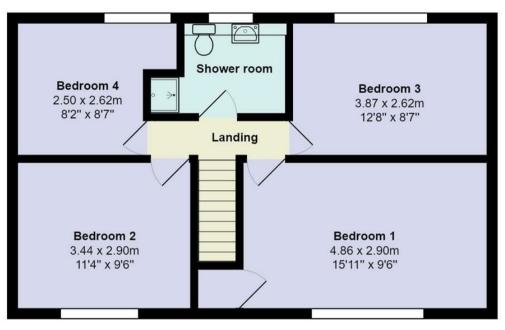
