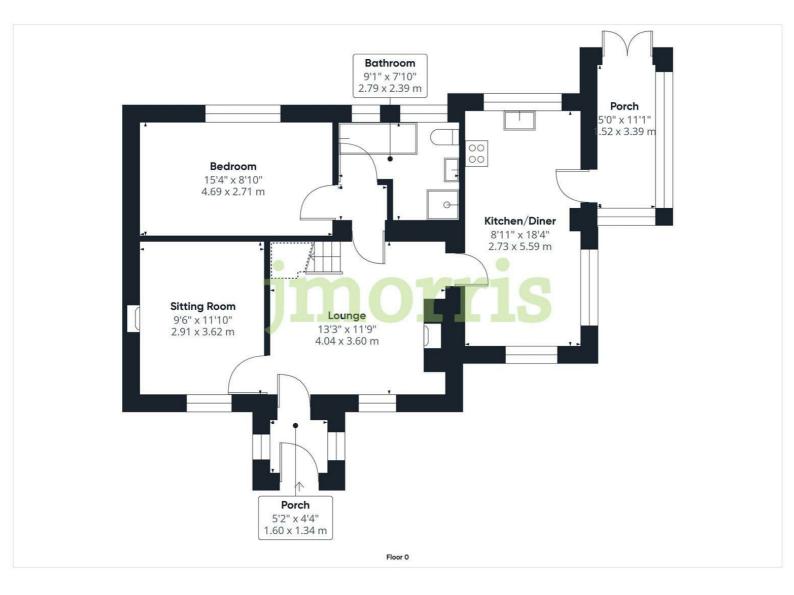

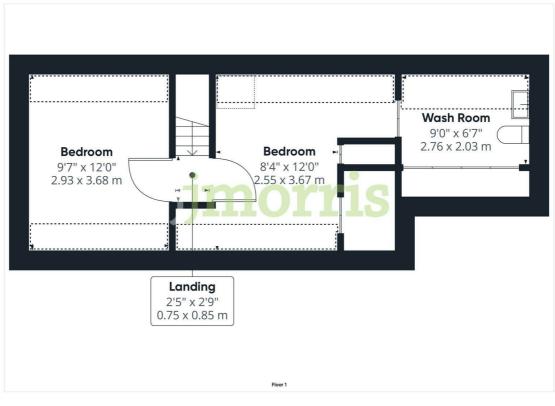

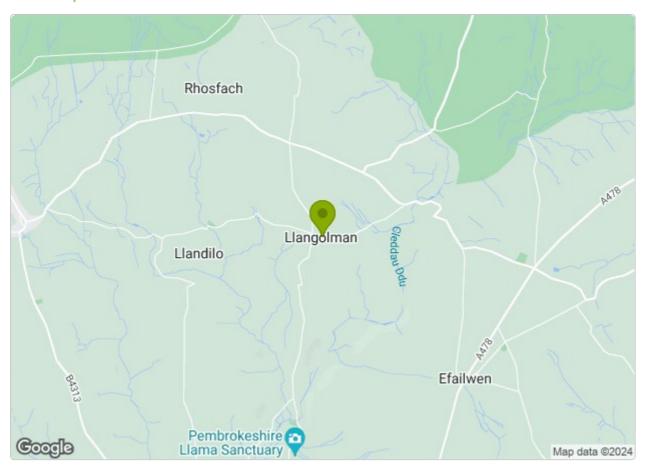
Directions

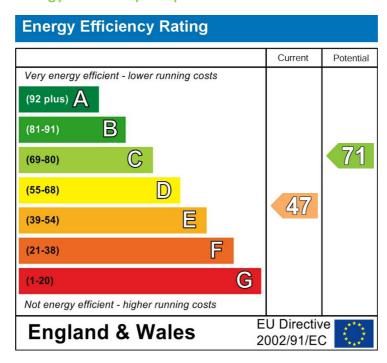




Area Map
