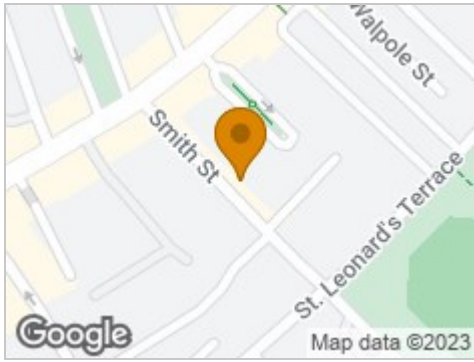

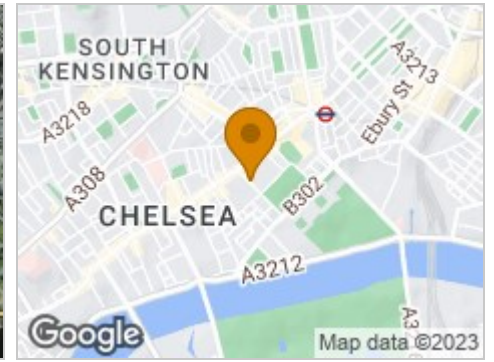
## Road Map

## Terrain Map



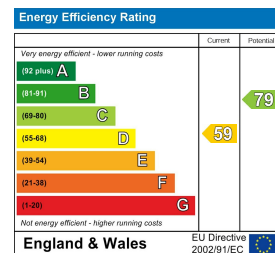
## Floor Plan
