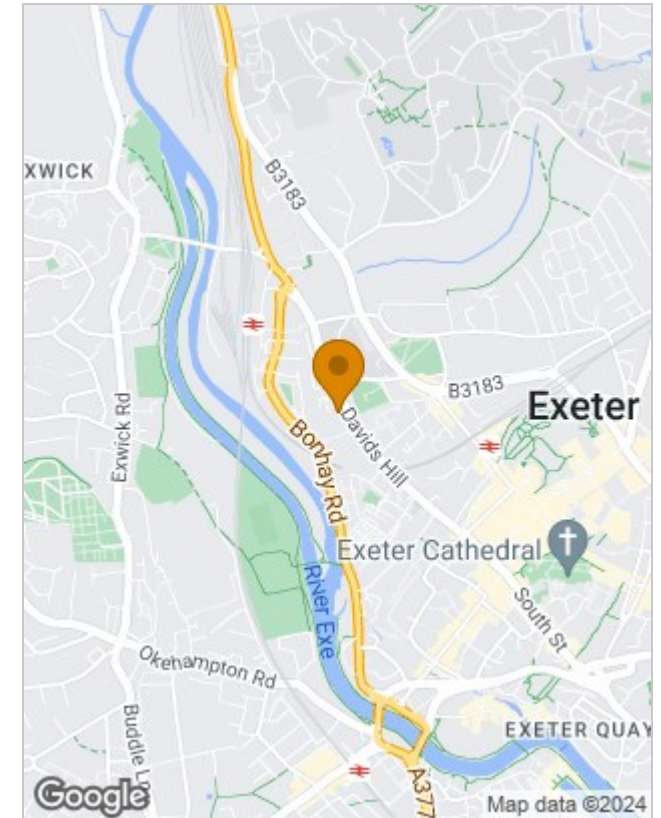




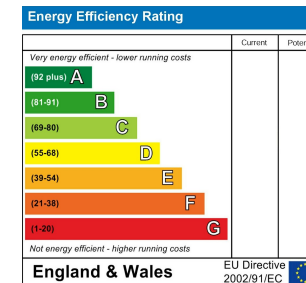
Floor Plans
