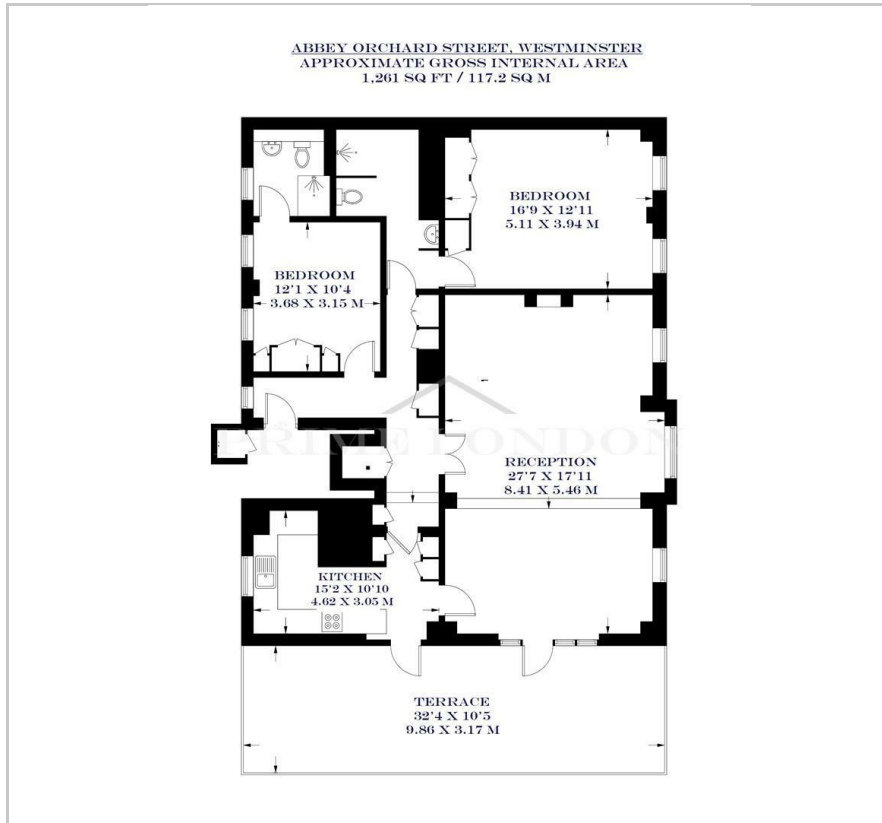

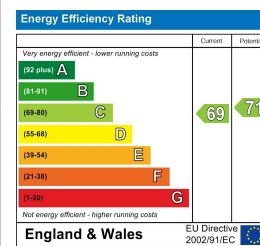
## Floor Plan
